Guide rails for building and analyzing a state-wide inventory

- → Industrial Sector site that either is zoned for industrial, existing prior industrial use or has the potential to be an industrial site think about sites that could accommodate certain types of investment (next slide!)
- → Level of Scale this is at a state-wide level; meant to capture larger scale potential (targets are >20 acres in suburban/rural and >5 acres for urban in-fill;) think about sites where state/local collaboration is needed
- Readiness Level from pipe dream requiring years of time to 'shovel-ready'; what are your priority sites what's the local need?



Cast a wide net to build an inventory that features a broad range of sites from undeveloped land to existing sites ready for transformative company investments.

This continuum gets at short and long-term opportunities.





Building the Inventory

Key steps to a state-wide inventory across the readiness continuum

- → Local/Regional RFI broad distribution of a two-section RFI to local EDCs, industrial development authorities, utilities some coordination will be necessary so multiple individuals don't waste time submitting the same local sites
- → Additional research consulting team is also mining LoopNet and CoStar to supplement RFI submissions
- → **Technical support** hosting a webinar on September 3 (2-3:30pm) to walk through the RFI and providing office hours to make completing the RFI as easy as possible
- → Applying the Evaluation Framework Deloitte will score each site submitted
- → Feedback submitting entity will receive site feedback from Deloitte



Building the Inventory

Deloitte will utilize an Evaluation Framework to conduct a quantitative assessment of site readiness
